He is responsible for managing the formulation of policies and strategies and implementation of programmes and initiatives to develop Hong Kong as a smart city, to promote the development of local IT industry and the collaboration with the Mainland, to draw up programmes and initiatives on digital inclusion and to enhance the effectiveness of Government's e-service to the public.
